SCHOOL DESCRIPTION

Parkview Baptist School is an independent, co-educational school with 1,334 students in PreK through 12th grades. PBS offers a quality college-preparatory, Christ-centered education. Parkview Baptist School is a ministry of Parkview Baptist Church and is approved by the Louisiana Department of Education and is accredited by the Southern Association of Independent Schools and Advanc-Ed (formerly SACS - Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.) Approximately ninety-six percent of Parkview’s graduates go on to post-secondary education each year.

Advanced Placement courses are currently offered in English Language, English Literature, Chemistry, Physics, Biology, US History, European History, US Government, Calculus AB, and Studio Art. Honors courses are offered in English, Math, Science, History and Foreign Language. Parkview Baptist School is consistently represented by students recognized through the National Merit Scholarship Corporation.
